Winter Weather, School Closures & the Late Start Schedule

It seems that Winter is finally starting to think about arriving! With the arrival of inclement weather, here is some information families need to know:

- School delay and closure information is first reported on the DPS website at www.dpsk12.org and on all of the major news channels.
- Information is added to the Kaiser Facebook page once we hear of it from the website and the news channels.
 We also work to change our phone message early in the morning for any incoming calls. The DPS website and news channels should be your first resource.
- 3. Kaiser is a 'LATE START' School. For planning purposes, buses that run to Kaiser will pick up students 1 hour later than they normally do. Staff will be at school at the normal time and the school will be open to any students at the usual arrival hours. Only the buses will run an hour late. Dismissal will be at the usual time.
- 4. DPS prioritizes keeping schools open in all kinds of weather as long as it is safe to do so. If you, as a parent, decide that it is unsafe or you are unable to get your child to school safely due to weather, please call us and let us know your child(ren) will be out.
- 5. We go out to recess when the temperature is above 20 degrees (including wind-chill), unless there is rain or snow coming down. Please ensure your student has appropriate clothing (coat, hat, mittens, boots and that these items are LABELED with your child's NAME). If you need help or a referral for winter clothing, please let us know.
